PSAC is offering a 3.5 day course, combining our Talking Union Basics (TUB) and our Local Officers' Training (LOT).

Members must attend all sessions (Thursday to Sunday):

Saturday, March 30	9am to 5pm	Sunday, March 31	9am to Noon

Location: Watson Lake Hospital Boardroom

TUB: This is the union's key introductory course – all members are encouraged to become better informed. The TUB is a prerequisite for all PSAC courses. You will learn about your rights in the workplace and in the union, and the role our unions play in our communities. You will also develop your understanding of the collective agreement and the grievance procedure.

LOT: This course is open to Local Officers, Stewards and members with interest about becoming an executive on their Local. Participants learn how to work together as a team to efficiently administer Local business and organize members at the workplace. The most beneficial experience would be to have more than one member from each Local participate in the course. Topics include: the role of the executive, local committees, local meetings, union-management consultation and sorting out the work.
