November 18, 2016 – Delegates from the QEC Bargaining Unit participated in an important Bargaining Conference in Iqaluit in early November to prepare for negotiations for a new collective agreement. The current collective agreement expires on December 31, 2016.

The **objectives** of the conference were the following:

- Review the proposals put forward by members,
- Begin preparing a package of bargaining demands,
- Elect your Bargaining Team for the negotiations, and
- Prioritize the demands.

The bargaining proposals will be finalized and made available to members after the Union exchanges proposals with the employer.
